



There are three different programs through the Pennsylvania Tax Credit Program that benefit students, schools, and businesses.

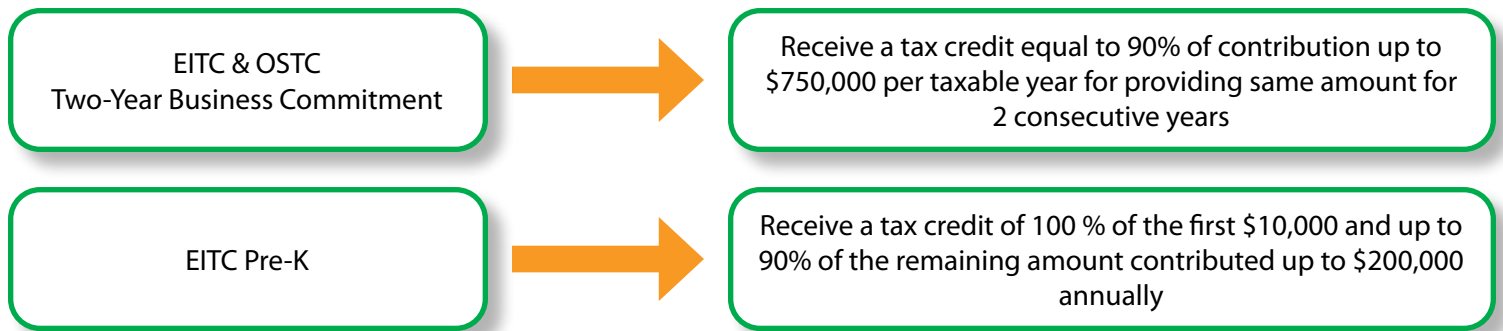
- Educational Improvement Tax Credit (EITC) K-12 Students
- Opportunity Scholarship Tax Credit (OSTC) K-12 Students who reside within the attendance radius of a low-achieving school.
- Educational Improvement Tax Credit PRE-K (EITC Pre-K) Pre-K Students

Student Eligibility for Scholarships

<i>EITC & Pre-K</i>	Household annual income less than \$92,160 plus \$16,222 for each dependent member of the household.	The scholarship awarded may not exceed the actual amount of tuition.
<i>OSTC</i>	EITC requirement + student must also reside within the attendance radius of a low-achieving school.	The scholarship awarded may not exceed \$8,500 per student.

Business Eligibility

Are you a business authorized to do business in Pennsylvania? Tax credits are awarded to eligible businesses, contributing to a state approved Scholarship Organization. Tax credits can only be applied against the tax liability of a business for the tax year in which the contribution was made.



Business Application Timeline

- **May 15** – Businesses who need to renew (In the middle of or at the end of a 2-year commitment)
- **July 1** – New business applications (Initial applicants or those submitting an additional application)
