



You can use your Missouri state income tax liability to provide scholarships for students to attend a Christian school.

### Who am I helping?

- Students with an IEP
- Students entering kindergarten or 1st grade, or who spent a semester of the last school year in public school
- Students at no more than 200% of the federal free/reduced income guidelines
- Students living in qualified areas of Missouri

### How can I help?

Connect with CTF and use 50% of your state income tax liability to get a 100% tax-credit. E.g., if your state income tax liability is \$5,000 you can send \$2,500 to CTF and get a \$2,500 tax-credit.



1. Determine your tax liability and reserve your tax-credits at [treasurer.mo.gov/MOScholars/ReservationApp](https://treasurer.mo.gov/MOScholars/ReservationApp)



2. Send your qualified contribution to CTF



4. Receive 100% tax-credit on up to half of your tax liability



3. CTF will verify your contribution with the state
